INFORMATION & UNDERSTANDINGS

Event Producer(s) reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any product, company and/or service in all vending booth area.

ERRL CUP IS AN ARIZONA MEDICAL MARIJUANA ACT EVENT, ALL RULES, LAWS AND GUIDELINES IN ACCORDANCE TO THE AMMA WILL BE ENFORCED AT THE ERRL CUP. ANY PARTICIPATE, VENDOR, PATIENT, OR ANY AND ALL PEOPLE NOT COMPLYING WITH THE AMMA WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT.

1. It is the responsibility of the Vendor to read the Information & Understandings and to understand its contents.
2. Vendor agree to adhere to the established operating hours of the event: 11am – 6pm. (3hr load in/out)
3. Vendors are fully liable/responsible for securing booth exhibits and merchandise at night.
4. It is the responsibility of the Vendor/Vendor booth holder to inform Errol Cup of any product, service or claim which does not comply with the regulations of the FDA or any other State or Federal regulatory agency and/or which is considered experimental.
5. Vendor/Vendors staff is strictly prohibited from having or selling on-site any substance or product considered being illegal.
6. Food and/or drink products can only be purchased at the event and cannot be brought in from outside vendors.
7. Vendor/Vendor booth must be open and staffed in ordinance with the events scheduled exhibition Hours as noted above.
8. All products and services to be sold, offered or referred to during Errol Cup 2016 must be included on the reservation form.
9. Errol Cup reserves the right to deny sale of items that have not been listed on the application.
10. Any Vendor/Vendor staff found to be selling or giving away items not listed on the application/pre-approved may be asked to leave the Festival without a refund.
11. No sublet or split booth space shall be permitted without prior written agreement with Producer.
12. No products may be handed out free to the public during the Festival (example: promotional balloons) without prior authorization. Distribution of samples and literature is strictly limited to the confines of the Vendor/Vendors booth.
13. No amplified voice and/or music amplification will be allowed so as not to disturb other Vendor/Vendor or attendees. (Unless written approval obtained from producer)
14. Aisles and Exits, as designated on approval show plans, shall be kept clean, clear, and free of obstacles. Booth construction shall be substantial and fixed in position in specified areas for the duration of the show. Easel, signs, etc., shall not be placed beyond the booth area into the aisles or lobby areas or on ceiling or columns, etc. Interior furnishings and materials shall not be located so as to obstruct or block exit ways, fire and safety devices or equipment. Working height restrictions within the hall are 8 feet.
15. Vendor/Vendors staff must comply with Errol Cup and Event location's rules.
16. Vendor/Vendors staff agrees to maintain dignity and integrity of the Events and will not perform any acts of a harmful nature. Errol Cup reserves the sole right to ask any Vendor/Vendors or its employees to leave the Festival whom they feel are not acting in the best interest of the Events.
17. Vendor/Vendors staff shall be aware and acknowledge the condition of the property and its possible hazards also that there is marijuana, medicated areas and smoking throughout the entire event and holds Errol Cup/Errol Cup Harmless on any related claims.
18. The producers will not be liable for refunds or any other liabilities whatsoever for the disruption of **events due to reasons of enclosure in which the events is to be produced, being before or during the Events by Oct 1 and will return booth fees to the Vendor/Vendor. Producer reserves the right to alter the booth layout plan at any time.**

19. Vendor/Vendors staff are financially responsible for any damage caused to booths, decorations, or to any of the Event location property. Do not nail, screw, staple, pin, tack, tape, etc., any materials directly to the property.
- 20.-No painting of signs, displays or other objects is permitted in the building. No adhesive-backed (stick-on) decals or similar items, excluding name tags, may be used in the building. "Glitter" is not permitted on carpeted areas of the building. Leave booth clean upon move-out or a charge will apply.
21. By law, individuals are not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages and consume them at the Events
22. No distracting signs at event.
23. We love animals at Errl Cup, but please no animals or pets are permitted in the building without prior approval with the exception of documented service animals.
24. Vendor/Vendors staff understands that Errl Cup's insurance does not cover Vendor in any way but would cover Errl Cup. The Vendor/Vendors staff shall obtain and maintain at its own policy/expense during the period commencing on the first move-in date and terminating on the last move-out date, a policy of insurance acceptable to Errl Cup. Vendor must send Errl Cup a copy of this policy with their application.
25. In the event that any outside cause such as war, fire, weather, supernatural, government, flood, any Act of God, etc. prevents Errl Cup event from taking place, the Management reserves the right to retain Vendor/Vendors payments for expense compensation.
26. The producers will not be liable for refunds or any other liabilities whatsoever for the disruption of the Events due to reasons of enclosure in which the Events is to be produced, being before or during the Events, destroyed by fire or other calamity, or by any Act of God (including but not limited to weather), public enemy, strikes, statutes, terrorists, ordinances or any other cause. Producer has the option to cancel the Festival by Oct 1, 2016 and will return booth fees to the Vendor. Producer reserves the right to alter the booth layout plan at any time.
27. No Vendor, Vendor agent, Vendor employee or any person associated with a state licensed Vendor in Arizona may giveaway medication, or sell medication at this event. If found to violate they will be escorted out of the event.
28. Vendor/Vendors staff understands the supposed supernatural/spiritual associations with the Event location and holds the Event location, Errl Cup/Errl Cup, the event organizer, its staff and associates harmless for any such related claims.
29. No Vendor, Vendor agent, Vendor employee or any person associated with a state
30. Vendor/Vendor agrees to all conditions, in regards to the safety at Errl Cup. There is glass, metal stakes, wildlife, falling concrete, holes, pits, brush, fire and many other things that could cause you or your employees or anyone associated with your company injury, DEATH, bodily harm, dismemberment, possession, blindness, pain, bleeding or any other things that could hurt you physically, mentally or spiritually. You understand by signing this and the enclosed separate waiver that Errl Cup, AZFDA, the organizers, The Event location or anyone associated with Errl Cup have no liability, no obligation financially or medical responsibility of you entering and staying, working, smoking, and any other activity that might be conducted at Errl Cup.
31. YOU UNDERSTAND YOU ENTER ERRL CUP AND THE EVENT LOCATION AT YOUR OWN RIDK. YOU CANNOT AND WILL NOT HOLD ERRL CUP, AZFDA, THE EVENT LOCATION OR ANYONE ASSOCIATED WITH ERRL CUP RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING THAT MIGHT HAPPEN TO YOU PHYSICALLY, MENTALLY, SPIRITUALLY AND SOCIALLY WHILE YOU ARE AT ERRL CUP AND ITS EVENT LOCATIONS.

DEADLINES

Once Vendor/Vendors has been notified of acceptance as a vendor in the Event, a copy of the required documents listed here in must be received in our office no later than fifteen (15) business days after receipt of written acceptance from Errl Cup. Your booth will not be fully confirmed until the payment is received in full.

Full payment must be completed at date of purchase, if no other arrangement have been made. Vendor/Vendor setup will not be permitted unless Producer has received signed contract(s), insurance forms, and all fees are paid. Credit cards on file will automatically be charged the booth balance on Dec 1 2016 unless prior arrangements are made.

REGULATIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

Vendor/Vendors staff are responsible for meeting all city/state resale-licensing requirements.

1. Vendor/Vendor agrees to abide by all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations pertaining to health, fire prevention, public safety, business licenses, sales tax permits and applicable liability insurance, including liability insurance for food booths before booth selection can be confirmed.

2. Vendor/Vendors staff is responsible for adhering to All federal, state and city regulations pertaining to fire and safety must be adhered to (i.e., all fabrics used in booth construction/decoration must be flame retardant).

Any Vendor/Vendor giving away or selling food in his/her booth is responsible for Health Department permits, rules, regulations, etc. please visit Department of Health's <http://www.azdhs.gov/phs/oe/h/fses/goods/handlers/> for more information. Vendor agree to permit photographs and video to be taken of their booths and their work at Errl Cup, to be used for the purposes of promoting and advertising the event. All photographs video footage remain the property of Errl Cup videographer will be identified as video photographer for Errl Cup.

3. The Vendor/Vendors staff agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Errl Cup, AZFDA, Errl Cup its owners, its agents, employees, and the Event location from any and all claims, causes of

Action suits, damages, theft, injuries and losses to any person or goods arising out of or connected in any way with the renting of space in the Festival.

4. Vendor/Vendor agrees that this release is intended to be a full and final compromise and release of any claims, demands, actions, and causes of action, known or unknown, and in consideration of this contract.

5. If payment is not made by the Vendor/Vendors as per this agreement, Errl Cup may cancel this agreement and release said exhibit space without notice of refund. By acceptance of this agreement, the Vendor/Vendors staff expressly releases from any and all liability for damage, injury, or loss to any person or goods which may arise from the rental and occupation of booth space. Signature acknowledges acceptance of terms located on this page and the next.

6. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in fines levied by Producer, Event location or Government agencies. Producer and Event location retain their right to close any exhibit that fails to cooperate with these policies.

7. This agreement constitutes the entire contract between AZFDA, dba Errl Cup and the Vendor/Vendor. No changes shall be valid unless agreed to by both parties in writing. Should AZFDA

Errl Cup or Errl Cup seek legal action to enforce this contract, Vendor/Vendor agrees to pay all fees and costs that the Errl Cup/ Errl Cup, its associates, legal team and staff incurs, whether or not legal action is instituted. Venue for such action is hereby agreed to be in Casa Grande, AZ.
